Criteria for Applying for Conference Grants

Objective

The Auckland Primary Catholic Principals' Association to set aside \$2500.00 each year for all Catholic schools to apply for a grant to attend education conferences, with particular preference being given to Catholic.

Procedures for Applying

1. All schools are eligible to apply for a grant.
2. The application must state the objective and the benefit to the Auckland Catholic Principals' wider community and to the school.
3. Provide the costing for travel, details of accommodation and attendees who will attend the conference.
4. If there is a demand for conference grants, preference will be given to:
 1. U1 & U2 schools.
 2. The type of conference, e.g. whether it is secular or Catholic.
 3. If there is an equal number of schools that qualify, the names will be drawn out of a hat.

Only 4 schools have requested financial support to attend the Catholic Convention in Wellington. These will be processed.

- **Attendance Dues Survey Results:** Response to the question as to who should collect attendance dues: CSO or Principals resulted in a 50/50 score. As it is not a majority of principals wanting this, we will not proceed in following this request.
